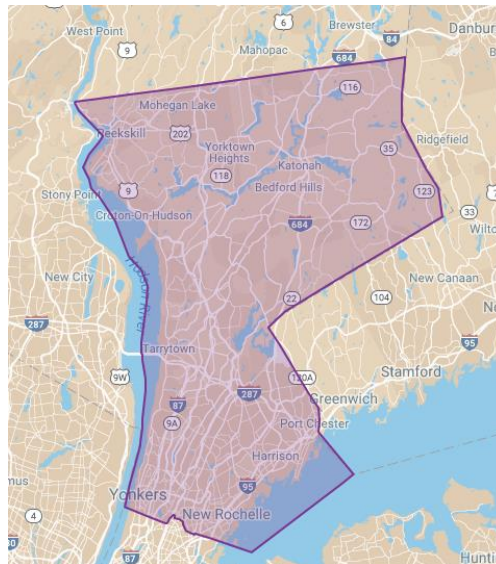

The Candidates

Challenger: George Latimer (D)

George Latimer is a Westchester County native who has served as a city councilman, county legislator, state assemblyman and state senator. As a Senator, he has been a strong advocate for local government services, infrastructure improvements, public education, and quality healthcare. George Latimer stands with CSEA in opposing a Constitutional Convention that would put pensions at risk.

Incumbent: Rob Astorino (R)

Rob Astorino has served as Westchester County Executive since 2010. Since he came into office, the county has failed to make proper investments in local services and Astorino has actively supported the consolidation of local governments and services. CSEA-represented county employees have been without a contract since the end of 2011, and the county workforce has been cut by 1,000 workers.
