You **must** submit the following with your application. Failure to submit **any** of the following items by due date April 3, 2024 will result in **automatic disqualification**.

- ✓ **A typed personal essay (300 words)** telling us about yourself and explaining your reasons for wanting to be a recipient of one of unit 9200's scholarships.
- ✓ **An official high school transcript** (must be in a sealed envelope).
- ✓ **Three recommendation letters** (Each letter must be in a sealed envelope).
 1. A letter of recommendation **from an organization** for which you did community service. Community service can be school related, but must not be a one-time event.
 2. A letter of recommendation from **either a Teacher or Guidance Counselor**.
 3. A personal letter of recommendation. This letter should not be from a relative.

Attach a copy of your parent's or guardian's CSEA membership card, or proof of membership. Parent or guardian must be a member in good standing and with at least one year of employment under the CSEA unit.

Box 1 - The Taxable Wages to be used for Federal Tax Returns.

Box 12 - Deferred Comp. Section 457- code (G)

Box 12 - Employer sponsored health coverage –code (DD) (nontaxable) **

****W-2 Health Coverage Reporting Requirement-**

The amount included in Box 12 using code DD on the W-2 is **not taxable** to the employee and is not included in any of the wage boxes. The reporting of the cost of employer-sponsored health coverage is for information only.

Detailed information from the IRS will be on the back of your W2 in regards to Box 12 code DD. The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, otherwise known as Health Care Reform, requires employers to report the total cost of health care on employee W-2 forms.

If you are enrolled in any health plan provided by Westchester County and are issued a W-2, you will notice the inclusion of this amount on your statement. The amount required is the total cost of health plan coverage, or the total premium cost of the plan for your particular annual election, taking into account any changes of coverage you may have had during the year (i.e. change of health plan election, change from individual to family coverage or family to individual coverage) and includes both the premium amount paid by Westchester County and any required employee contribution.

Re: 2024 Payroll Information

2024 will have twenty-six (26) pay periods and 262 working days upon which the bi-weekly gross pay for annual salaried employees will be calculated.

The 2024 F.I.C.A. tax rate will remain the same at 6.20% with an annual cap of \$168,600.

The Medicare F.I.C.A. tax rate is 1.45% on all taxable wages up to \$200,000, and 2.35% on all taxable wages in excess of \$200,000.

For your REGULAR pay wages; only the FEDERAL withholding tax rates have changed. NYS, NYC & Yonkers withholding tax rates have NOT changed.

Supplemental tax rates are as follows for lump sum payments and wages other than regular pay: (No changes for 2024)

- The Federal flat tax rate is 22%.
- The New York State flat tax rate is 11.70%.
- The N.Y. City resident flat tax rate is 4.25%.
- The Yonkers resident flat tax rate is 1.96%.
- The Yonkers non-resident flat tax rate is .50%.

The W-2 tax forms will be mailed by the end of January. Employees should be aware that address changes should be in by January 12th to be certain that they will be included on the W-2 form.

2024 Irving Flaumenbaum Memorial Scholarship, Pearl Insurance and MetLife Scholarships

It is with great pleasure that we announce the **2024 Irving Flaumenbaum Memorial Scholarship Program**. High School Seniors who apply for the Flaumenbaum Scholarship are automatically in the running for the **Pearl Insurance and MetLife Insurance Company Scholarships**.

In total, \$23,000 in scholarship money is available to CSEA members' children. High school seniors are eligible to apply.

The Irving Flaumenbaum Award will provide eighteen \$1,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors; three in each region. Irving was a spirited CSEA activist for more than three decades. He was President of Long Island Region 1 and an AFSCME International Vice President at the time of his death.

The Pearl Insurance and MetLife Insurance Company Scholarships will provide two awards of \$2,500 each. The top 2% of scholastic achievers, based on high school average, class rank and SAT scores, will be selected to create the eligibility pool for this scholarship.

The Pearl Insurance Award is in memory of Charles Foster, a longtime CSEA activist who began with CSEA in the 1930s. Mr. Foster was also the first business officer of the SUNY system and, in recognition of that, this scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior entering the SUNY system.

The MetLife Award is named for Joseph D. Lochner, CSEA's first employee and former Executive Director who spent over forty years in service to this union.

Application **deadline** is **May 1, 2024**. Winners will be notified in July and announced on the CSEA website.
